EM - Snapfinger Vault and Trunk Sewer Assessment and Cleaning (Emergency): for use by the Department of Watershed Management (DWM). This temporary contract consists of the assessment and cleaning of known sites experiencing Sanitary Sewer Overflows (SSOs) during rain events. Use of the Totally Integrated Sonar and Closed Circuit Television (TISCIT) inspection technique will allow the contractor the ability to view and clean away the debris leading to current reductions in sewer capacity. This request seeks to ratify the emergency purchase of large diameter trunk sewer assessment and cleaning services. Awarded to Compliance Envirosystems, LLC. Amount Not To Exceed \$5,096,263.15.
