CPO Horner: the traffic services were originally bid in a manner that did not coincide with the same unit of measurement that the builders had done. That ambiguity was cleared up, and now all awardees use the same unit of measurement.

<sup>-</sup>Question RP: this also reference a 18% spike in marginal costs. Is that typical?

D Hayes: that is part of change order 5, and not so much part of this change order that we're addressing

Z Williams: this item does not speak to that specifically. There is a future item that deals with that. Asphalt, labor, pipe, construction all contribute to increases in the costs. We can answer in more detail when we get to that item.
