II. STATUS UPDATE

Code Red Project

-presentation provided by DEMA Director Cox

-Question TT: How many people are currently opted in to receive alerts?

J Cox: almost 32,000 residents. Detailed information is in a later slide.

-Question MDJ: How does this differ than what we currently get in an emergency?

J Cox: This is from the County, others are from the State. Any County related emergencies are from us. we are the mass communication channel for the County.

-Question MDJ: The numbers that you have - how do you get those numbers? I've received notices but I don't believe I've signed up

J Cox: we will be bringing forth an item, 0566, during the next cycle to support our mass communication contract.

FY23 Budget Adjustment

-FLOCK Cameras budget discussion provided by Chief Ramos - Police

Ramos: Current proposal is for 31 flock cameras including 1 year use and installation at \$113,150.00. If you want to go into the second year without fees it is \$93,000.

- -Question MLS: could you provide a copy of which districts will be having these cameras?

- -MLS: if you could please have someone reach out to my office to provide me more information on the FLOCK camera capabilities
