<u>2023-0113</u>	Commission District(s): 4 & 7 Agreement for the Construction and Financing of Sewer Upgrades with Captura Rockbridge Acquisition I LLC Not to Exceed \$150,500. <i>New Agenda Items</i>
<u>2023-0321</u>	Commission District(s): All CO - Change Order No. 2 to Contract No. 1297573 Debris Collection Services (Emergency Purchase): for use by Public Works - Sanitation. This contract consists of debris collection routes at the North Collection Lot. Awarded to Russell Landscape, LLC. This request is to increase funds and the contract term through June 30, 2024. Amount Not To Exceed: \$1,950,000.00.
