We have completed a peer review of the Office of Independent Internal Audit of the Dekalb County Georgia Government for the period May 1, 2019 through April 30, 2022. In accordance with generally accepted government auditing standards peer review requirements, we followed the standards and guidelines contained in the *Peer Review Guide* published by the Association of Local Government Auditors (ALGA).

Our procedures included:
