

RISK-LIMITING AUDIT RESULTS

Risk-Limiting Audits

After every General Election, Georgia conducts a Risk-Limiting Audit (RLA) of a contest selected by the Secretary of State's office. An RLA is a hand audit of selected ballots designed to demonstrate that the outcome of the election has been declared correctly.

For the November 8 General Election, Georgia counties audited the Secretary of State contest. The state selected a risk limit of 5%, meaning that successful completion of the audit would demonstrate a less than 5% chance that the outcome had been declared in error. DeKalb County tallied a sample of batches by hand on November 17 at the Voter Registration and Elections Stonecrest facility at 2994 Turner Hill Rd, Stonecrest, GA 30038.

The ballots were counted by thirteen teams of two and one vote review panel.

Batches Counted

The state's partner, VotingWorks, randomly selected three batches for DeKalb to count, totaling 5,709 ballots:

Results

In general, a slight margin of error can be expected in a hand count. However, in this case there were no discrepancies found.
