Katherine Valley Water Main Replacement Project Begins May 19

DECATUR, Ga.— Efforts to improve the watershed system throughout DeKalb County continue on **Monday, May 19** with the launch of the Katherine Valley Water Main Replacement Project. Crews will replace 5,400 linear feet of aging pipelines. ***The line repair project is expected to last approximately 7 months (May to December 2025), barring any weather delays.***

Normal construction hours will be from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through Friday, excluding major holidays. An increase in construction-related noise and traffic during work hours should be expected.
