Glendale III Water Main Replacement Project is Underway

Construction to install new water main pipes

DECATUR, Ga. – Efforts to improve the watershed system throughout DeKalb County continue with the Glendale III Water Main Replacement Project. Crews are replacing approximately 11,900 linear feet of ductile iron water pipe on Celia Way, Midlawn Drive, Hamilton Road and Columbia Drive with other intersections impacted.

This water improvement project is expected to last approximately one year (December 2025 to December 2026), barring any weather delays.


This project is part of DeKalb County's \$4.27 billion capital improvement program to improve capacity and service of the watershed systems serving the community.

Normal construction hours will be from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday through Friday, excluding major holidays. An increase in construction-related noise and traffic during work hours should be expected.
