Greetings,

As part of DeKalb County's \$4.27 Billion Capital Improvement Program, the Department of Watershed Management (DWM) continues to improve the capacity and service of the Watershed systems serving your community with the **Peachtree Boulevard Water Transmission Main Replacement Project**.

This letter serves as formal notification that construction activities continue with Phase II of the project. Phase II runs along the northbound side of Peachtree Boulevard from Malone Drive to Carver Drive. A virtual community meeting about the project will be held on **Thursday, Jan. 29 at 6:30 p.m.** via Zoom at:

Please be advised to expect an **increase in construction-related noise and traffic** during work hours. Normal construction hours will be from **9 a.m. to 4 p.m., Monday through Friday, excluding major holidays**. Property/business owners will be notified **48 to 72 hours** prior to the start of impactful construction activities. Our construction crews will work persistently to minimize the length of impact to businesses, residents and motorists.

Crews have completed Phase I (Malone Drive) and have installed 1,548 linear feet of 12-inch and 1,820 linear feet of 36-inch pipe thus far. The 11,000 linear foot project is expected to be completed in December 2027.

Ruby Collins, working on behalf of DeKalb County, is the authorized contractor for the **Peachtree Boulevard Water Transmission Main Replacement Project**. All workers will be wearing proper identification.
