As part of DeKalb County's \$4.27 billion capital improvement program, the Department of Watershed Management (DWM) will be improving the capacity and service of the watershed systems serving your community. The **Consent Decree Package 7 Comp 4 – Cliff Valley Sewer Improvement Project** has been designed to improve the sewer system in your community.

This letter serves as formal notification that construction activities associated with this project will start on **Oct. 13, 2025**. Crews will replace approximately 4,362 linear feet of ductile iron sewer in the Cliff Valley Way area. This project is expected to last approximately two years (October 2025 to October 2027), barring any weather delays.

Normal construction hours will be from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday through Friday, excluding major holidays. An increase in construction-related noise and traffic during work hours should be expected.

**Ruby-Collins**, working on behalf of DeKalb County, is the authorized contractor for the **Consent Decree Package 7 Comp 4 – Cliff Valley Sewer Improvement Project**. All workers will be wearing proper identification and driving marked vehicles.
