- DeKalb County Entered into Modified Consent Decree
 (MCD) in 2021, Included Specific Projects and Milestones
- The North Fork/ South Fork Peachtree Creek Trunk Sewer Upsizing Project— Critical Path
- Completion Milestone Under the Current MCD -December 2027
- Sewer Master Plan Identified Numerous Trunk Sewers that Require to Carry 2050 Projected Flows




Conditions of Existing North Fork/ South Fork Peachtree Creek Trunk Sewer Upsizing Project


















Example of Right of Entry Form (ROE) and Easement Plat




