COMMISSION DISTRICT 5

Commission District 5 covers the southeastern portion of the county, including the cities of Lithonia and Stonecrest. 41% of the district's population lives in these two cities, while 59% lives in unincorporated DeKalb. Some notable sites in the district include Arabia Mountain National Heritage Area, Vaughters Farm, the Flat Rock Archives, and the South River. The district has been represented by Commissioner Mereda Davis Johnson since 2015.

POPULATION CHARACTERISTICS

The district had a population of about 155K in the 2020 Census, up an increase of 16K from 2010. The population of District 5 has increased steadily over the past few decades and is projected to continue increasing in coming years.



Adults aged 20-40 make up the largest share of any age range. The district has a lower share of senior citizens compared to the county as a whole. The district notably has a lower share of people in their 50s and 60s compared to the county as a whole. Nearly 90% of the population identifies as Black or African-American, the highest of any of the Commission Districts. (Source: US Census)

At 64%, the overwhelming majority of the workforce in District 5 is classified as "White Collar", a category that includes most office and professional jobs. The unemployment rate for the district is above the county average of 4%. (Source: ACS 2024)

TRANSPORTATION TO WORK







The overwhelming majority of workers in District 5 commute to work via automobile, with most of those driving alone. The district has higher commutes on average relative to the county, due to the district being located farther away from major employment centers in the region. Most workers in the district have a commute time of between 20 and 34 minutes. The workforce is fairly evenly split between people who work inside of DeKalb County and people who work outside it.
