


INTRODUCTION



SUPER DISTRICT 7

Super District 7 covers the eastern half of DeKalb County, including the cities of Doraville, Tucker, Pine Lake, Stone Mountain, Stonecrest and Lithonia. 31% of the district's population lives in incorporated areas, while 69% lives in unincorporated DeKalb. Some notable landmarks in the district include Stone Mountain, Arabia Mountain National Heritage Area, Mercer University Atlanta Campus, and Sanford Performing Arts and Community Center. The district has been represented by Commissioner Lorraine Cochran- Johnson since 2019.








POPULATION TRENDS AND KEY FEATURES

The district had a population of about 380K in the 2020 Census, up 30K from 2010. The population of District 7 has increased steadily over the past few decades and is projected to continue increasing in coming years.










Adults aged 20-40 make up the largest share of any age range. The district has a lower share of senior citizens compared to the county as a whole. The district notably has a lower share of people in their 50s and 60s compared to the county as a whole. The major racial group of the district is Black or African American, at around 70%. 






The vast majority of housing in the district was built post-1960, with the largest share being built between 1970-1990. New housing construction dropped off significantly in the 2010s as a result of the Great Recession. The district's housing stock is, on average newer relative to the county as a whole. Homeowners make up a majority of the district over renters by roughly a 3-2 margin. (Source: ACS 2021)

At 66%, the overwhelming majority of the workforce in District 7 is classified as "White Collar", a category that includes most office and professional jobs. The unemployment rate for the district is above the county average of 4%. (Source: ACS 2022)

in District 7 commute to work via automobile, with most of those driving alone. Despite the presence of a MARTA rail line in the district, only 6% of workers take public transportation.
