## **DeKalb County Courthouse Parking Deck Renovation Project**

DeKalb County, Georgia – June 7, 2024 – DeKalb County SPLOST (Special Purpose Local Options Sales Tax) is a one cent sales tax that provides funding exclusively for capital projects – roads, building, vehicles and major equipment, and other long-lived improvements.

These pennies are making it possible to fund many improvements in DeKalb County. One of those improvements is the DeKalb County Courthouse Parking Deck Renovation. Built more than 40 years ago, this viable project will extend the life of the building, providing safety for courthouse justices and citizens of DeKalb County.

The DeKalb County Courthouse Parking Deck project focused on repairs and improvements to the parking deck and immediate surrounding area.

Aspects of the project include repairs to concrete and steel beams, columns, connections, steel plates, expansion joints, waterproofing, new electrical LED lighting, elevator modernization, fire protection piping, way finding signage, stairwell modifications, and pressure washing all the exterior facades.

DeKalb County allocated \$9,895,518.75 from SPLOST funds to complete the repairs. The project is scheduled to be completed in August of 2025.
