Subject: The 2nd and 3rd Avenue Sewer Improvement Project Road Closure

Dear Resident/Homeowner,

As part of DeKalb County's \$4.27 billion capital improvement program, the Department of Watershed Management (DWM) will be improving the capacity and service of the watershed systems serving your community. The **2nd and 3rd Avenue Sewer Improvement Project** has been designed to improve the watershed system in your community.

As a result of the work being completed, please be advised of the following road closures:

- 2nd Avenue: Ongoing - September 19, 2025
- 3rd Avenue: September 29 – October 17, 2025

Detour signage will be installed to direct traffic around the impacted areas. These dates are subject to change based on weather conditions.

Normal construction hours will be from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday through Friday, excluding major holidays. An increase in construction-related noise and traffic during work hours should be expected.

Kemi Construction, working on behalf of DeKalb County, is the authorized contractor for the **2nd and 3rd Avenue Sewer Improvement Project**. All workers will be wearing proper identification and driving marked vehicles.
