## **Dunwoody Knoll Water Main Replacement Project Begins October 6**

*Construction to install new water main pipes*

**DECATUR, Ga.** – Efforts to improve the watershed system throughout DeKalb County continue **Monday, Oct. 6**, with the launch of the Dunwoody Knoll Water Main Replacement Project. Crews will replace approximately 14,500 linear feet of ductile iron water pipe between Roberts Drive and Redfield Road.

***This water improvement project is expected to last approximately 12 months (October 2025 to October 2026), barring any weather delays.***

This project is part of DeKalb County's \$4.27 billion capital improvement program to improve capacity and service of the watershed systems serving the community.

***Normal construction hours will be from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday through Friday, excluding major holidays.*** An increase in construction-related noise and traffic during work hours should be expected.
