The DeKalb County Department of Watershed Management's Office of Engineering & Construction Management Services (ECMS) has initiated a project to make improvements to the watershed system in your community.

As part of your community's water system upgrade, workers will be flushing new pipes to ensure clean, safe water. During flushing, fire hydrants will be opened, causing water to **spray into the air like small geysers** and flow down the street temporarily. This is a normal part of the process to clear the pipes and improve water quality.

Work in your area is scheduled to take place in the next 24-48 hours. Flushing is expected to last 6-8 hours.

Our construction crews will work diligently to minimize the length of impact to residents. Also, please note all staff working on behalf of DeKalb County will have proper identification and will drive marked contractor vehicles.
