Subject: Gravity Sewer Rehabilitation and Replacement Project (Keheley Drive)

Dear Resident/Homeowner,

As part of DeKalb County's \$4.27 billion capital improvement program, the Department of Watershed Management (DWM) will be improving the capacity and service of the watershed systems serving your community. The **Gravity Sewer Rehabilitation and Replacement Project** has been designed to improve the watershed system in your community.

This letter serves as formal notification that construction activities associated with this project will start on **April 7, 2025**. Crews will replace approximately 1,230 linear feet of gravity sewer main on Keheley Drive between Windell Drive and Melody Lane. This project is expected to last approximately four months (April 2025 to August 2025), barring any weather delays.

Normal construction hours will be from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday through Friday, excluding major holidays. An increase in construction-related noise and traffic during work hours should be expected.

KEMI Construction, working on behalf of DeKalb County, is the authorized contractor for the **Gravity Sewer Rehabilitation and Replacement Project**. All workers will be wearing proper identification and driving marked vehicles.
