Delcourt Drive Water Line Replacement Project Begins April 4

Construction to install 8-inch-diameter water line system

DECATUR, Ga. – Efforts to improve water service capacity throughout DeKalb County continues on Monday, April 4, with the launch of the Delcourt Drive Water Line Replacement Project. Crews will replace 7,500 linear feet of crumbling water lines with new 8-inch ductile-iron water lines along Delcourt Drive. This line repair project is expected to last approximately 12 months (April 2022 to March 2023), barring any weather delays.

Normal construction hours will be from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through Friday, excluding major holidays. An increase in construction-related noise and traffic during work hours should be expected.
