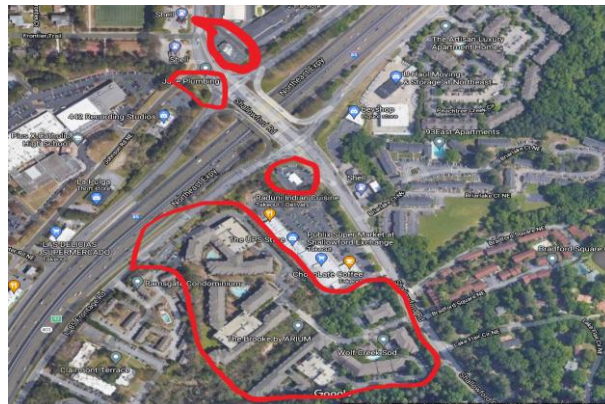

**Shallowford Road Water Service Interruption  
Planned for May 4**  
*Repairs will be made to leaking water main*

**ATLANTA, Ga.** – On **Tuesday, May 4**, DeKalb County and its contractors will temporarily interrupt water service to businesses and residents between 2308 and 2960 Shallowford Road from **8 a.m. to 6 p.m.**, to replace a leaking 30-inch-diameter water line. Residents and businesses may experience low water pressure or service interruption for several hours.



This work is being performed as a part of the annual water and sewer construction administered by the DeKalb County Office of Engineering & Construction Management Services.

Under the program, water mains throughout the county are being replaced with new pipelines to repair damaged lines, improve water pressure, quality, and reliability of water service.

DWM contractors have been provided with strict instructions to restore all water service on the dates of interruption unless emergency circumstances arise.
