South McDonough Street Lane Closure Begins Aug. 2
Construction to repair 272 linear feet of aging sewer pipe

DECATUR, Ga. – On **Aug. 2**, a portion of the northbound lane along **South McDonough Street**, between **Hill Street** and **Griffin Circle**, will be closed from **9 a.m. to 2 p.m.**, while crews work to rehabilitate 272 linear feet of ductile-iron sewer pipe. This section of South McDonough Street will reopen on **Wednesday, Aug. 7**.



The DeKalb County Department of Watershed Management has initiated this construction project to address the repair needs of approximately 100,000 linear feet of sewer pipe as a part of ongoing maintenance to improve sewer service countywide.
