East College Avenue Lane Closure Begins on Sept. 8

Overnight construction to rehabilitate aging sewer pipe

DECATUR, Ga. – On **Tuesday**, **Sept. 8**, lane closures are set to begin for portions of the northbound and southbound lanes along **East College Avenue**, between **Sams Street** and **New Street**, from **9 p.m. to 5 a.m.**, while crews work to rehabilitate 692 linear feet of ductile-iron sewer pipe. This section of East College Avenue will reopen on **Saturday**, **Sept. 19**.



The DeKalb County Department of Watershed Management has initiated this construction project to address the repair needs of approximately 100,000 linear feet of sewer pipe as a part of ongoing maintenance to improve sewer service countywide.
