Homeowner Eligibility

- Homeowner must be a DeKalb County resident
- Homeowner must not have received previous DeKalb County repair or homeowner rehabilitation assistance
- The house where the work is to be done must be the primary residence
- Homeowner must be elderly (62 or older) or disabled and 21 years of age or older
- Homeowner's total household income must be at or below 60% of the Area Median Income, as defined by HUD

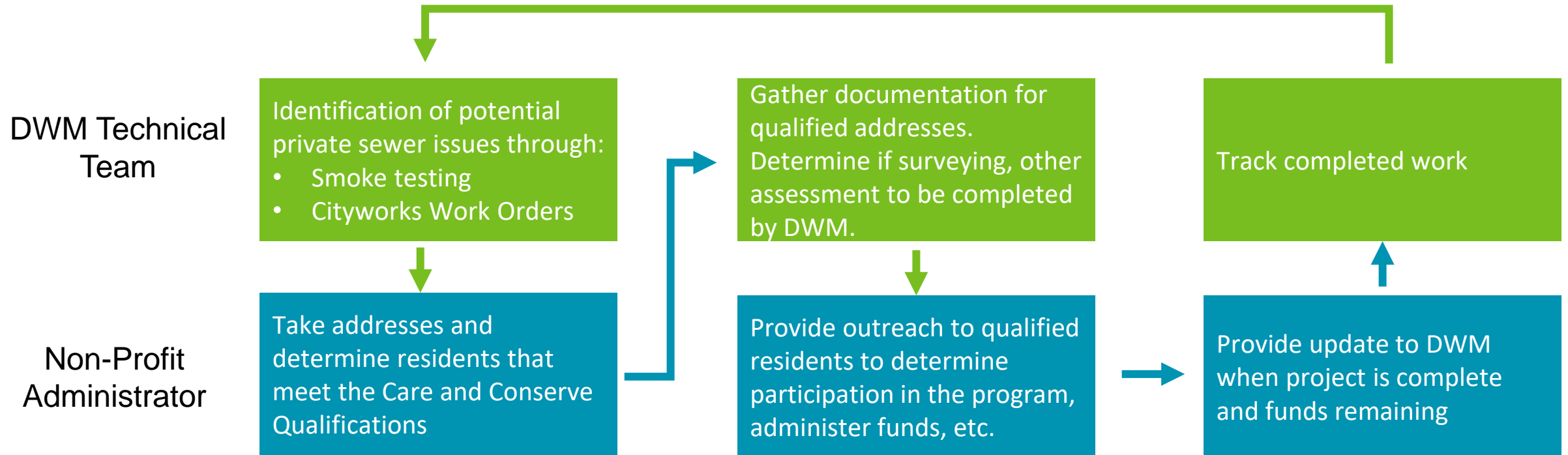
1. Private Sewer Lateral Remediation

Potential sewer lateral issues

- Structural defects in the sewer lateral allowing infiltration of stormwater into the sewer
- Connections of roof drains, area drains, etc. allowing inflow of stormwater runoff into the sewer
- Slope issues in laterals creating risk of building backups
- Lack of cleanout on property line to allow investigation of location of sewer lateral issues



Private Sewer Lateral Remediation

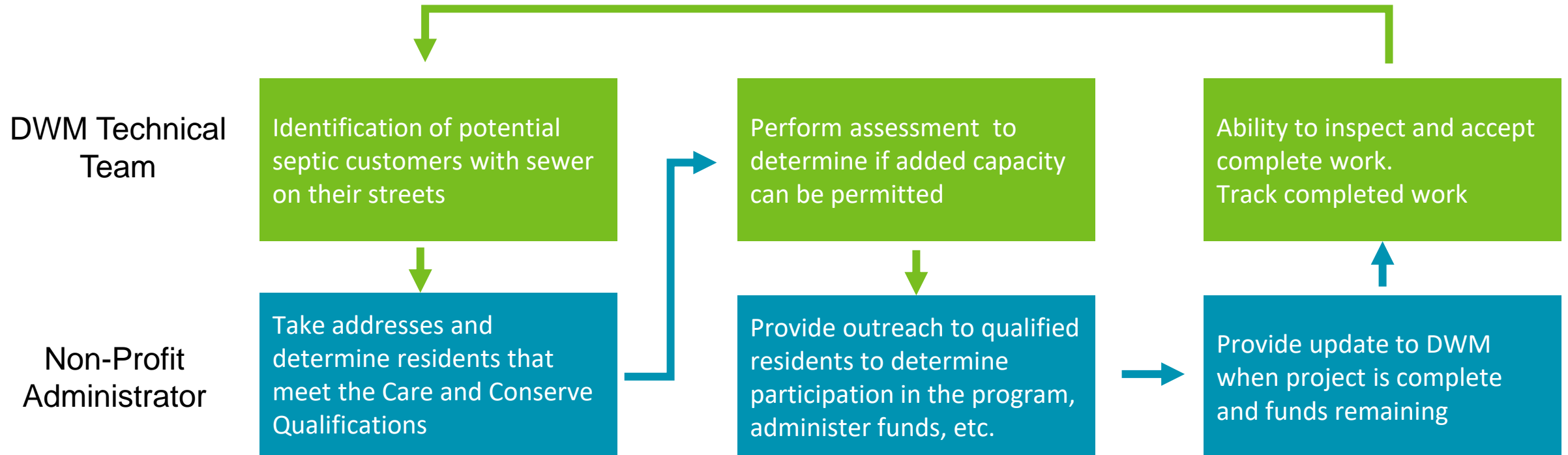


2. Septic to Sewer

- **Goal:** Assist those in need with sewer available on their street to connect to the sewer system
- **Key activities:**
 - Identify recipients
 - Determine eligibility
 - Model sewer system and approve capacity.

3. Water Leaks

- **Goal:** Assist those in need with water leaks to repair the leak
- **Key activities:**
 - Identify customers with leaks from billing data
 - Determine eligibility
 - If not already done, convert to AMI transmitters for electronic usage reporting/Advanced Metering Infrastructure (AMI).
