

Perimeter Summit Valve Repair Begins March 13

Crews will repair damaged water valve

DECATUR, Ga.—DeKalb County Watershed Management crews will replace and/or repair a malfunctioning valve at the intersection of **Ashford Dunwoody Road** and **Perimeter Summit Parkway.** A portion of the northbound lane will be closed on **Sunday, March 13, at 8:30 a.m.,** while crews make repairs and restore service during a planned water outage. This section of **Ashford Dunwoody Road** will reopen on **Monday, March 14.**



This work is being performed as ongoing maintenance of the county's water infrastructure.
