## 6 8. SPLOST Updates

7 Chris Kingsbury, DeKalb County SPLOST program manager, gave an update on SPLOST, including revenue

- projections, road resurfacing lists and future master-planning for County-Line Ellenwood Park. The full

- 10 Delores Crowell, Intergovernmental Affairs Manager, presents from the CEO's office and informs that
- 11 Nov. 21 is not available as a meeting date.
- 12 Motion: Change the November SPLOST Oversight Group meeting date from Thursday, Nov. 21, to
- 13 Wednesday, Nov. 20. Motion introduced by Teresa Hardy. Motion seconded by Jenna Teston. Motion
- 14 carries.
- 15 Gina Mangham requests the record reflect that she cannot be present.

## 16 9. Public Comment

- Monica Wood: States she can't find information on SPLOST parks projects online and doesn't like the way minutes are developed. States her son plays basketball and there aren't a lot of basketball places for kids to play.

- 22 Lena Render: States she didn't receive notice of the SPLOST Oversight Group meeting. Requests
- 23 sidewalks on River and Linecrest roads near the new County Line-Ellenwood library, sheds at MARTA bus
- stops, street lights and expansion of County Line-Ellenwood Park to include 46 acres on River Road.
- 25 **Stephen Binney:** States SPLOST Board of Commissioner discretionary funds will have to be presented
- 26 and voted on during commission meetings. States E-Host was good for cities but unincorporated DeKalb
- 27 didn't see a change, and unequal wealth distribution means South DeKalb isn't benefitting as much.
- 28 States SPLOST is funding projects that previously were general spending. Requests the Oversight Group
- 29 to take a close look at spending and change orders.
