3 road resurfacing progress.

4 Delores Crowell presented from the CEO's office and passed out copies of Georgia Trend Magazine,
5 which featured DeKalb County.

7 **Lena Render:** Requests sidewalks on River and Linecrest and Flakes Mill roads, especially near the new
8 County Line-Ellenwood library, and street lights near MARTA bus stops. States this meeting and other
9 county meetings need to be publicized. There needs to be signage in the community for the library and
10 park. MARTA bus stops needs shelters and benches.

11 **Stephen Binney:** States the SPLOST oversight group should consider asking the Board of Commissioners
12 who takes their SPLOST committee minutes and request that person. Suggests a calendar-year time
13 frame for an annual report. Requests the oversight group review contracts, projects and timelines.
